Restaurant Icon, Diane Powers, Receives Lifetime Achievement Award from California Restaurant Association

Diane Powers, Owner-Operator of Bazaar del Mundo Shops and Restaurants was recognized by the California Restaurant Association (CRA) with its Lifetime Achievement award at the San Diego Chapter's 38th Annual Gold Medallion Awards on June 13.

"This prestigious award not only recognizes Diane's exceptional restaurateur skills and warm hospitality, but also acknowledges her significant contributions in shaping the local restaurant community," said CRA Board Member Susie Baumann. "As a founding member of our chapter, Diane's dedication has been instrumental in establishing and furthering San Diego's dining scene."

Powers' legacy started in 1971 when she opened Casa de Pico in a run-down motel in Old Town San Diego. Over 50 years later, her restaurants – Casa Guadalajara in Old Town, Casa de Pico in La Mesa and Casa de Bandini in Carlsbad
– are home to award-winning
Mexican cuisine, vibrant courtyards, breezy outdoor patios and
trumpeting mariachis.

The CRA San Diego Chapter's Annual Gold Medallion Awards serves as an opportunity to bring together premier industry leaders and San Diego's most prominent restaurants to celebrate the area's culinary experience.

Attention Retail Businesses: Organic Waste Recycling Waiver

The City's Recycling Ordinance is a mandatory policy requiring the public to separate recyclable material and newly added organic waste materials at residences, businesses, mixed use facilities and permitted special events.

Recyclable materials include:

Plastic, glass bottles and jars, paper, newspaper, metal containers, cardboard, rigid plastics including clean food containers, jugs, tubs, trays, pots, buckets and toys.

New organic waste recyclable materials include:

Food scraps and food-soiled paper from kitchens and food operations and yard waste such as garden and landscape waste and nonhazardous wood waste.

The recycling ordinance updates ensure the City is complying with the mandatory state law Senate Bill 1383 (SB 1383). The new law requires the reduction of organic waste currently disposed of in landfills.

A De Minimis Waiver (Minimal Generation Waiver) may be granted if:

The commercial business' total solid waste collection service is two (2) cubic yards or more per week and organic waste comprises less than 20-gallons per week; or,

The commercial business' total solid waste collection service is less than two (2) cubic yards per week and organic waste comprises less than 10-gallons per week.

If a business would like to be considered for a De Minimis Waiver and fit one of the two thresholds listed above, they can now request a waiver online.

Download the Get It Done App & Get Results

Get It Done San Diego is the official app for reporting non-emergency problems to the City of San Diego. App users can report problems like potholes or graffiti and connect directly to the City's work tracking system.

Get It Done can be used to report problems related to City assets, making appointments for Passport services or to schedule time at the City's Household Hazardous Waste Materials drop-off facility. Do not use Get It Done for reporting emergencies or other time-sensitive issues. It can take up to 48 hours to review your report or request for appointment.
